Procedure for Entry

All exhibits must be the work of the exhibitor and must have been created after the previous year's County Fair. All entries must have *(Name, Age, Division, Class, and Category)*. Use may use the included tags (see page 4). Be sure tag is secured on your item. If tag is not secured, item may not be judged or returned to you.

All art must be created on a 12x8 sheet of paper or smaller. 3D Art is not restricted by size limitations, but size must be deemed reasonable.

Judging procedures for Division B will be the same as for adults. Ribbons will be awarded based on quality of work submitted.
